#### <u>Introduction</u>

Greenfields School are continuously striving to improve the outcomes for young people we work with. It is imperative that we receive feedback from all stakeholders of the school, from learners to staff, managers to care home providers and multi-agency professionals in order for us to be able to meet the needs of our learners and effectively develop the provision.

The following report outlines the views and opinions of stakeholders; our feedback has considerably lower to previous years due to meetings continuing to be hold virtually because of COVID and although the questionnaire was sent electronically not many people completed.

We need to further develop feedback so it is an on-going process for the school, therefore giving us a continuous view of how the school itself and the processes in place to run the school function as per Estyn and Greenfields/Caretech requirements.

The evidence used is data collated up to 19th July 2022 to produce this report.

#### **Executive summary**

This report presents the key findings from the consultation feedback of stakeholders.

There was one source of consultation feedback:

 An online survey on Google forms where respondents completed various questions which included rating scales, the questions varied dependent on the person completing the form.

Feedback was submitted by key stakeholders we also include learner views in this report and Yr11 leaver feedback which is a new development.


Throughout the feedback it is evident that the majority of respondents are more than happy with the school, the main findings of strength is the nurturing environment & personalised approach, some comments refer to them being flexible, and adaptable enabling the learners to achieve their set outcomes.

They responded that the school has a good standard of education with positive statements being provided and 100% positive in response to school safeguarding systems.

Matters of improvement that were highlighted were concern around


100% of respondents were satisfied with our school provision and would recommend us to others.

I would recommend Greenfields school to others




In relation to learners enjoying their school experience, guardians gave us 100% response.

My child likes the school.




Learner response was many learners happy at school with 1 learner stating they sometimes enjoyed school.


Are you happy at school?





In relation to learners feeling safe at school, guardians gave us 100% response.






Are you satisfied with Greenfields School Safeguarding systems





Learner response was mostly yes with 1 learner stating they sometimes agreed due to conflict with another learner which has been addressed.

Most stakeholders are satisfied with our educational provision & felt we communicated effectively.






The school communicate effectively.




We have moved school sites but we maintained communication via email, used Seesaw and continued to attend meetings for individual learners this academic year. Respondents also felt that the school was effectively run.

The school has had to move to full remote learning for 3 periods of 12 days over the last 12 months following increase/contact with residential homes and positive cases within the educational team.

Very good.


Very professional

We were delighted that the school managed to re-ignite in our child an interest and commitment to learning which we thought, through past school experiences, had been lost. On a personal level we would like to see the school expand significantly so it had the staff base to maintain 'on site' learning even when there is a flare up of illness/covid. Our son has not been able to engage in the online provision so the frequent shifts to online learning have had a detrimental impact. The most impressive part of the teaching has been the school's willingness to adapt to our son's individual needs and to provide a curriculum in which he could thrive. For such a small, specialist school we are very grateful for their determination and commitment on this.


Teachers are very positive. friendly and welcoming. They are very accommodating to the needs of the children and offer a wide range of subjects to suit the individuals.

Exceptional school that is understanding of students with wide variety of needs, caring approach to learners and they enjoy coming for first time in their education

The expectations are high to achieve and children are pushed to achieve their full potential

Nurturing and all plans are individualised.

When asked if learners received appropriate additional support in relation to their individual needs stakeholders responded with:

Our son has learnt more about managing his emotions while at Greenfields than at any other education provision. The school have seen the need for the development of these essential life skills and have embodied the learning of these into our son's daily experience of Greenfields. Throughout his two year experience his emotional well-being has been prized and nurtured. The school demonstrated unconditional positive regard for our child while also holding firm boundaries and high expectations - this is in such stark contrast to his past educational experiences and we will forever be grateful. We have witnessed our child heal for all the harm he experienced when his last educational placement failed through the support of Greenfields. We witnessed Greenfields nurturing him (and us) in the recovery, daily demonstrate to him his worth and gradually guide him back into education. Our son has ended his school years knowing he is valued, a person of worth - regardless of his struggles and seeing himself as a person capable of learning and achieving as others do. Greenfields have given our son and us a gift we would never have thought possible when he joined in March 2020. We know it is a gift he can carry forward in life and are we are extremely grateful to the whole Greenfields community for this.

Good trips & good vocation, helping me get where I need to be for my future.


Teachers are good & this school understands some days are hard for me
